## Frequently Asked Questions

### *Classes*

There are two classes for this event – Super Electronics (SE), Pro Non-Electronics (NE). Any car with electronics (delay box, throttle stop, etc.) MUST run in the SE class. Cars without electronics will run in NE. Motorcycles are not permitted in either class. The same car cannot be run in both classes, but a competitor can run in both classes with a different car in each.

### *Tree*

Both classes will be run on a .500 full tree, with autostart. Crosstalk will be used for the Super Electronics class. If you do not want cross talk, you must put an “N” next to your dial-in.

### *Car Numbers / Dial-Ins*

Car numbers and dial-ins must be displayed on both the front windshield and on the driver’s side window.

### *How will the 2 entries per class per driver work?*

For each class (Super Electronics / Non-Electronics) there will be two separate sub-classes run, which will meet at the finals. For example, if you double enter the SE class, you will compete in both SE1 and SE2. You will run in each sub-class, just as if you were running in separate races, until you are eliminated. The final round will be contested between the winner in SE1 and the winner in SE2. Only one payout is made for the winner and runner-up. The runner-up from the individual sub-class finals will be paid at the semi-final level. Payouts between the eighths and the semis will be paid separately per sub-class. For example, if you make it to the semi-finals in both sub-classes, you will receive two payouts. For those racers who chose to contest only one entry, they will be placed into either SE1 or SE2, as necessary to balance out the car count between the sub-classes.

1<sup>st</sup> round will be random pairings, all subsequent rounds will be ladder.

### *Thursday Test & Tune*

Thursday’s test and tune session is scheduled to run from 4 pm to 7 pm. It will be extended, if necessary, to ensure all racers get an equal number of runs.

### *Time Trials*

Each class will get 2 time trial runs on Friday morning before going into eliminations. The same format will be run Saturday. No time trials will be run on Sunday.

### *Rain-Out Policy*

If the entire event is rained out, it will be re-scheduled for another weekend. If 2 of the 3 days are able to be contested it will be deemed to be a complete race, and no refunds will be given.

### *Schedule*

A more detailed schedule for each day will be provided when you get your racer credentials.
